

The Mayflower



- The Mayflower is the name of the ship that carried the Pilgrims from England to Plymouth, Massachusetts in 1620.
- The voyage lasted for 66 days.
- The Pilgrims landed on Cape Cod (what is now Provincetown MA) on November 21, 1620.
- Their final destination of Plymouth was reached the day after Christmas.
- There were 102 settlers that completed the voyage.
- The Mayflower was a square-rigged sailing ship.
- It is estimated to have weighed 180 tons.
- Its length was approximately 113 feet long.
- The keel was about 64 feet with a board with of about 25 feet.
- The captain of the Mayflower was Myles Standish.
