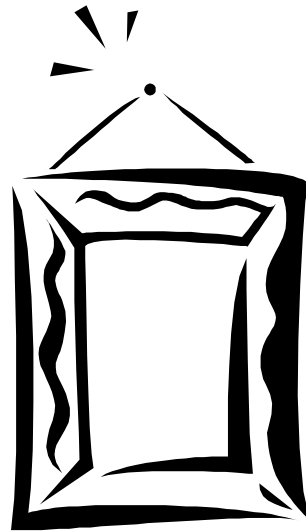


Picture Frame

Materials:

- Corrugated cardboard
- Pebbles, twigs, macaroni, etc.
- Clear plastic
- Tag board
- Tape
- Metal bracket (picture hanger)
- Acrylic paint, paintbrushes
- X-acto® knife
- Glue
- Photograph



Steps:

1. Cut the cardboard into the desired shape for a frame.
2. Cut a hole in the cardboard large enough for the picture to show through using the X-acto® knife.
3. Glue pebbles or chosen objects around the frame.
4. Paint the frame, front and edges, with desired colors and let dry.
5. Staple a piece of clear plastic, the photograph, and a piece of tag board together on the top and bottom edges.
6. Tape the stapled items to the back of the frame so that the picture shows through.
7. Glue metal bracket on back of frame so it can be hung on the wall.
